NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * The building will not be available for set-up on Thursday evening.
- ❖ NO PARKING on the grass!
- Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds, and will be excused from the crating area.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. The Club will refund all but ten (10) dollars per day of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian (on letterhead) stating that the bitch is in season. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of classes or by letter postmarked prior to July 20, 2007.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. WCWDCA and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be enforced and if complaints are received, dogs will be moved.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Dogs in the Preferred class MUST run in their proper height class.

As of January 1, 2001, all agility dogs are required to have a Jump Height Card and owners must present it prior to running in any class. **PLEASE SEND A PHOTOCOPY OF THE DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH THE ENTRY FORM.** *Note—all exhibitors should carry the original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.

For dogs without a valid Jump Height Card: Any dog that has not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by the judge of record prior to running at each trial. If no AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official is present, the judge of record will wicket all dogs, except those in the 24" and 26" class, before they run and that measurement will be for that weekend of trials only. If a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility.

All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface. Ring sizes will be 85' x 100' or greater.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-though is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class.

First Place Blue Second Place . . . Red Third Place . . . Yellow Fourth Place . . White Qualifying Score Dark Green

A new-title rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.

A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to teams that attain their MACH.

A dog toy valued at one to four dollars will be awarded to all dogs that place 1 st- 4th in their respective height and class.
