NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ❖ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ❖ **The building will NOT be available for set-up on Thursday evening.**
- ❖ **NO PARKING** on the grass!
- ❖ Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds, and will be excused from the crating area.
- ❖ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- ❖ **REFUND POLICY:**
All refunds after the closing date and time are at the discretion of the show-giving club. Please remember that these refunds are a courtesy of the club (not an AKC requirement). In order to be considered, the requests must be received by the Trial Secretary, in writing by the Wednesday following the trial.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund all but \$5.00 dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason.

All refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- ❖ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. WCWDCA and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- ❖ Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be enforced and if complaints are received, dogs will be moved.
- ❖ **This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**
- ❖ Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- ❖ All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- ❖ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- ❖ Dogs **MAY NOT** be left overnight. The WCWDCA will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- ❖ Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$10.00 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the show date at a cost of \$12.00.
- ❖ **Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. NO EX-PENS.**
- ❖ **NO CLEATED SHOES** of any kind will be permitted on the field turf surface.
- ❖ **Good Food** will be available on site both days.

Entry Information

- ❖ Entries open Monday, May 18, 2009 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 450 Excellent runs on Friday and 660 runs per day on Saturday and Sunday. The method of entry is **Random Draw**. Entries for the Random Draw will be taken between Monday, May 18, 2009 at 8:00 a.m. and Tuesday, June 9, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. The drawing, if necessary, will be held on June 10, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. at the address of the Trial Secretary, 5474 Delphinium Ct., Columbia, MD 21045. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Entries close Thursday, July 2, 2009 at 6 p.m.
- ❖ Entry fees are \$18.00 per run/per day. (Each entry fee, each day includes \$3 AKC recording fee. Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.)
- ❖ **Fax/Credit Card entries** will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa or MasterCard**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$3.50 per dog. (Trials may not be combined.) All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. - ❖ **PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE.** Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)

Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Dogs in the Preferred class **MUST** run in their proper height class.

As of January 1, 2001, all agility dogs are required to have a Jump Height Card and owners must present it prior to running in any class. *Note—all exhibitors should carry the original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.

For dogs with a Jump Height Card: PLEASE **SEND A COPY OF THE DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH THE ENTRY FORM.** Height cards are **not kept "on file" from previous trials.**

For dogs without a Jump Height Card: All dogs that have not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by the judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. If no AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official is present, the judge of record will measure all dogs, (except those in the 24" and 26" class) before they run and that measurement will be for that weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Yellow Form **must** be measured before they run.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 (fifteen) months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility and are supplied by MAD Agility.

All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface. Ring sizes will be 85' x 100' or greater.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Up

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Ribbons and Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class.

First Place Blue
Second Place . . . Red
Third Place . . . Yellow
Fourth Place . . White
Qualifying Score Dark Green

A new-title rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.
A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to teams that attain their MACH.
A PAX rosette will be awarded to teams that attain their PAX.

NOTE: Workers' Draw List

Due to the Random Draw Entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the trial committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work 2 or more classes each day of the trial they have entered. If you are willing to be on the worker list, please fill out the Volunteer form, noting what you would like to do.

The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
