DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From the 495 Capital Beltway:

From Virginia and West: Take the Washington DC Beltway (I495/I95) across the Wilson Bridge. Continue 14 miles to Pennsylvania Ave.. (Route 4). Turn South on Route 4 toward Upper Marlboro, MD. Continue for 9 miles to Route 301. Turn South of Rt. 301 and continue 6.3 miles to Rosaryville State Park on your right. Enter park and follow signs.

From Baltimore and North: Proceed South on I95 to the Washington DC Beltway (I495/I95). Proceed South (inner loop) 19.5 miles to Pennsylvania Ave (Route 4) Follow the above directions.

TRACKING REGULATION CAUTIONARY DISCLAIMER

No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead" – due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.

NOTICE

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent and accompanied by appropriate entry fee. Entries will be acknowledged provided there is a legible email address where you can be reached.

In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations, entries in this match shall be accepted up until the official closing date even though the advertised limit has been reached. The drawing for this match shall take place on February 6th, 2008 at 7:00 PM Local Time at 407 Greenlow Rd, Catonsville, MD. At that time, it will be determined which of the entries will participate in the event. The drawing will be at random among all entries but preference will be given to Weimaraners that have not previously earned a tracking title. When the limit (4) has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn in the same manner and two (2) shall be assigned a position on the alternate list. All entries will be notified of their entry status and a Judging Program will be mailed or emailed as soon as practical after entries close and the draw is completed. Should you not receive such acknowledgement within a reasonable amount of time, please contact the Event Secretary.

Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do not run, and entrants replaced by an alternate at the match. Entry fees will be refunded within seven (7) days following the match date. In the event an accepted entry cancels prior to the match date, the event secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the alternate list and upon notification, said alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the match.

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8.

Passing dogs will receive certifications necessary for entry into TD Tests.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements of a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).

The WCWDCA is pleased to announce that Jack Sappenfield is returning to hold another tracking seminar. Jack, a member of the Tarheel Weimaraner Club, is an AKC Tracking Judge, and has successfully helped train numerous dogs and their handlers. He held a similar seminar in 2005, which was enthusiastically embraced by WCWDCA members. This year's seminar will be similar, and cover basic concepts of tracking, and will include a brief exposure to basic tracks. This is an ideal way to introduce your puppies, and older friends, to tracking. The all day seminar will be held at the Canine Training Association's Davidsonville training facility (Directions are below).

Space is limited to the first 20 people, one dog per person please! The cost per dog is \$35, which includes lunch. For those who would like to attend the seminar as an observer, WITHOUT a dog, the cost is \$15 per person. Please use the attached form.

The day before, Saturday, February 16th, the WCWDCA will hold an AKC sanctioned Tracking Match at Rosaryville State Park in Upper Marlboro. Members are welcome to come out and watch dogs work tracks to see what tracking is all about!

Directions to CTA training facility in Davidsonville:

Westbound Rt. 50 take the 424 exit toward Davidsonville (turn left at the end of the exit ramp). Follow Rt. 424 (Davidsonville Road) for 6.8 miles to the traffic light intersection with Central Avenue (Rt. 214). You will be directly across from Homestead Gardens and the Davidsonville County Store. Turn right onto Central Avenue (Rt. 214). Drive .7 miles, passing Lakemont Memorial Gardens Cemetery followed by the Davidsonville Elementary and Middle schools. Turn left onto Queen Anne Bridge Road directly across from the Davidsonville Elementary School. Follow this road for approximately 1 mile. Stay to the right, on Queen Anne Bridge Road, at the Y intersection with Wayson Road. The Davidsonville Recreation Center (Formerly Military Nike Missile Site) is immediately ahead beyond the chain link fence. In about 1 block you will see the entrance gates to the Davidsonville Recreation Center, turn left into the parking lot. If you intersect with Patuxent River Road you have missed the Davidsonville Recreation Site and must turn around. Once on the Davidsonville Family Recreation Center property follow the road between the two low 1 story white cinder block building and drive to the top of the hill. CTA is the building to the right with the large plate glass windows. For better directions go to Mapquest and type in 3789 Queen Anne Bridge Road, Davidsonville, MD 21035 for your end point.
