Directions:

From Chesapeake Bay Bridge, MD. Take Route 50 east to Rt 301 North. Turn right on Rte. 304 East. Left on Rt. 312 in Bridgetown. Right onto Rt. 287, which becomes Route 10 in De. turn right in Petersburg onto Firetower Rd. Turn right onto C&R Center Rd. Bear right at fork. C&R Center driveway is on left about ½ mile.

From Dover: Take Route 13 south to the traffic light in Viola, there is a used furniture store on the corner turn right on Evens Road cross RR tracks to "T" and turn right on Firetower Rd to left on C&R Center Road drive approximately 0.6 miles to the C & R Center driveway on the left. The building is located well back off the main road.
