Access Permit Effective January 1, 2012

Effective January 1, 2012; The Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF)requires an Access Permit for visitors to department-owned Wildlife Management Areas(WMAs) and public fishing lakes, who are age 17 and older, *unless they possess a valid Virginia hunting, freshwater fishing, or trapping license, or a current Virginia boat registration*. Daily or Annual Access Permits for WMAs and department-owned public fishing lakes statewide are available for purchase online, by calling 1-866-721-6911 during business hours, or at any license agent.. Daily Access Permits can be consecutive up to five days. The cost of six daily permits would be \$24, slightly more than the annual fee. At that point, it makes more sense to purchase an Annual Access Permit. Cost for the Daily Access Permit is \$4. Cost for the Annual Access Permit is \$23.
